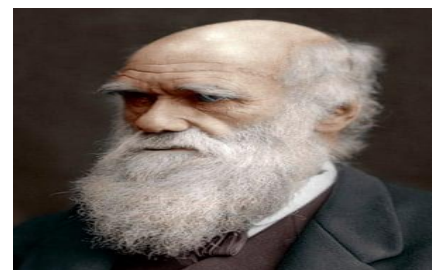


Our Year 6 theme for this half term is:

English
