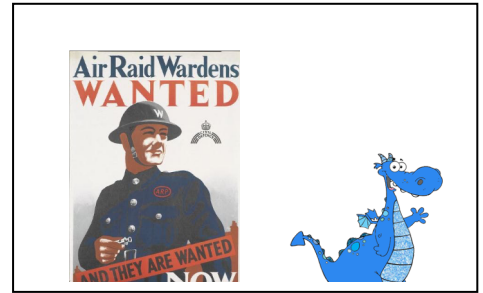


Our Year 6 topic for this half term is:
