Computing

- Continue to save, retrieve and edit work.
- Using 2animate to create a short animation by adding details to each frame.
- Be able to use tools to create images.

- Learning about Chinese New Year celebrations.
- Understand the importance of Respect and Responsibility (Teach Peace).

Maths

- Revisiting subtraction and addition applying newly taught strategies.
- Solving a range of problems by choosing the correct strategy.
- Continuing to apply our number bond knowledge.
- Exploring the concepts of length and time.

Science
