

## Topic Homework in Year 3: Stone Age, Bronze Age and Iron Age

This term in Year 3, we are looking at the Stone Age, Bronze Age and Iron Age.

<p>Imagine you have travelled back in time to the Bronze Age. Write a letter back to your family to tell them about your experiences.</p> <p>Use different conjunctions to extend sentences</p> <p>E.g. while, so, if, as...</p> <p>Use different sentence types e.g. statements, commands, exclamations and questions</p>	<p>Create a collage of a prehistoric Bronze Age scene.</p> <p>Plan what will be in your collage scene (e.g. landscape, people, animals) Choose different papers and materials (reuse and recycle!)</p> 	<p>Compare your life with the life of a child in prehistoric Britain.</p> <p>Was there anything that was the same as life today? You might like to write a list or draw a table to explain your ideas. What was different?</p> <p>What was the same?</p> <p>(Homes, families, food, towns, education)</p>
<p>Write an acrostic poem about the Stone Age.</p> <p>Remember to include historical information and as a challenge try to include some rhyme.</p>	 <p>Create your own tool from the Bronze Age.</p> <p>Think carefully about which materials you will use, how you can cut and shape materials and decorate it effectively.</p>	<p>Which rocks/metal do you think would be best to use during the Bronze Age?</p> <p>Explain your reasons.</p> <p>Think about the hardness of the rocks – durability of the metal and how they found the materials.</p>
<p>Use natural materials to create a Stone Age picture.</p> <p>Create types of paint by crushing berries, grass leaves and other natural materials.</p>	<p>Create a model or an A3 picture of a Bronze Age village or shelter.</p> <p>Try to make sure you find out what these dwellings were really like and include facts around your model.</p>	<p>Research anything that you find interesting about the Stone Age or Bronze Age.</p> <p>Think about a creative way to share your knowledge with others.</p> <p>E.g. A large poster, a presentation, or a game.</p>
<p>Create a Stone Age recipe using only ingredients that were available at that time.</p> <p>Remember they were hunter gatherers and to write your recipe down.</p> 	<p>Create your own model showing a Stone Age and Bronze Age tool making scene.</p> <p>E.g. Start with a scene about how bronze was made, create a scene about how the tools were crafted/shaped and then show how the tools were used.</p> <p>You might even do all 3 scenes!</p>	<p>What is mining?</p> <p>Research what it is and what it would be like doing this job during the Bronze Age.</p> <p>Consider where and how we get tin and copper.</p>
