Our theme for Summer 1 is:
Life on Board!



English

- Read & spell Common Exception Words.
- Write and organise information in different ways e.g. lists, leaflets and postcards.
- Practise segmenting and blending skills.
- Explore rich texts and revise the skills we have learned in Shared Reading.

Maths

- Doubling and halving numbers to 10.
- Using learned strategies to solve problems.
- Combining and portioning numbers to 20.
- Applying known addition and subtraction facts to numbers up to 20.

Science

- Learn how to complete some simple class investigations.
- Talk about what happened/what we saw.
- Work in a small group listening to the ideas of others.

Computing

- Use code to make a computer program.
- Understand what objects and actions are.
- Understand what an event is.
- Use object, actions and event code blocks to make things happen.

Geography

- Name and locate the 5 oceans of the world.
- Use simple compass points, North, South, East, and West.

History

- Learn about the life of Nelson.
- Learn about HMS Victory.
- Understand the significance of Portsmouth in the life of Nelson and the HMS Victory.
- Look at how life on board would have been on HMS Victory and on other vessels.
- Compare life on board modern and historical ships.

P.E.

- Perform dances using simple movements.
- Develop coordination skills through dance.

Ways to support your child at home.

- Continue to read with your child for at least 10 minutes every day. Remember to ask them questions about the book so they can talk about what they read with you.
- Use NumBots to practice Maths skills.
- Allow them opportunities to practise their phonics knowledge (Phase 3, 4 and 5)
