Our topic for the first two weeks will have a big focus on History as we teach some key elements to the children. Following this, our topic will change to another 'water' inspired one with a different focus. We believe that this will engage the children as well as make their learning more logical and appear more 'fun'.

 <u>English</u> Read & spell Common Exception Words. Write and organise information in different ways e.g. lists, messages. Practise segmenting and blending skills. 	<u>Maths</u> Compare numbers by looking at the tens and ones (of a number) Count in 2s, 5s and 10s from any number. Talk about the patterns that you notice.
<u>History</u> • Recap our knowledge of Neil Armstrong as an explorer. • Learn about the life of Christopher Columbus and his journey to America. • Compare Columbus' achievements to Armstrone	<u>Science</u> • Learn how to complete some simple class investigations. • Talk about what happened/what we saw. • Work in a small group listening to the ideas of others.
