Geography

- Name the 5 Oceans of the World
- Use maps, globes and atlases to identify the oceans
- Understand that Columbus sailed across the Atlantic Ocean
- Read simple compass directions
- Use compass directions on a map

- Identify everyday potential dangers
- Understand how to keep safe
- Understand why rules are important

Music

- Explore rhythm.
- Learn songs linked to the topic, such as sea shanties.

- Move in different ways outdoors
