Here are 6 ideas for Home Learning activities. Aim to complete as many of the tasks as possible.

<p><u>English/History</u></p> <p>We will be learning about Queen Victoria and the changes that were made in her life time that still affect us today.</p> <p>Research Queen Victoria's family and then create a family tree for her. You could then create your own history tree!</p>  	<p><u>Maths</u></p> <p>We are further developing our addition and subtraction skills. We have started by adding single digits (e.g. <math>21 + 3</math>).
