We will be:



English

- Writing coherently in different styles ensuring that we include:
 - Different sentence types
 - A range of conjunctions
 - Correct punctuation
 - Neat & well-formed handwriting
 - Spelling words using the prefixes and suffixes which we have learnt
 - Correct spellings

Maths

- Learning about different measures. This includes; mass, capacity and length.
- Recapping addition and subtraction skills.

Computing

- Creating and debugging simple programming sequences.

Science
