- We will be developing our ball skills by throwing and catching.




Expressive Arts Design/DT/PSHE

We will be learning to:

- Develop our pencil skills and sketch a Duckling then to use charcoals.
- Smudge and blend using oil pastels in the style of Kandinsky.
- Understand how to join materials to make an opening for a Post Box.
- Talk about the Duck eggs and Ducklings observe how they change and grow.
- Understand how to keep healthy e.g. cleaning our teeth.
- Listen to the Easter story and understand how Easter is celebrated.

Mathematics

We will be learning about







Time-We will order and sequence important times in their day and use language such as now, before, later, soon, after, then and next to describe when events happen. We will also begin to recognise that regular events happen on the same day each weekend and use the vocabulary 'yesterday', 'today' and 'tomorrow' to describe when events happen.



<u>Literacy-Reading and Phonics</u>

Segmenting and Blending–We will continue to use the Phase 3 sounds to read words e.g. ch-o-p/r-ai-n Can you use your Robot arms to help you?

Reading Sentences—We will be using our keyword knowledge and phonic skills to read sentences.

Phase 3/4– We will be re-calling our Phase 3 phonemes, digraphs and trigraphs, hearing and finding them in words.
