


Curriculum Letter Summer 2nd Half 2022 Above and Below



This term we will be starting off by going to Pirate school and learning different skills to be a Pirate e.g. singing sea sharties and making Pirate accessories. We will then be learning about what lives in the sea and on the shore.

Physical Development- Gross and Fine Motor Skills

We will be learning to:

- a good 'team player' and support other members of our team in a game of 'Scatterball'.
- create a sequence of movements for an 'Ocean Dance' in time with music.





Expressive Arts Design/Science/PSHE/History

We will be learning to:

- Design and create a boat to test in water and to see if it floats or sinks.
- Create a water colour collage in the style of Van Gogh.
- Talk about different sea creatures that live above and below the water.
- Understand the importance of sea safety.
- Share our feelings on 'transition' and moving to a new class in September.
- Compare what Southsea seafront look liked in the past and today.

Mathematics

In Maths we will be learning:

- To re-call our number bond knowledge.
- To double numbers in practical activities e.g. double 2 is 4.
- To halve amounts through sharing. "I have 4 sweets how many can I share with a friend?"
- To use real objects to see that the quantity of a group can be changed by taking items away.
- To develop our understanding of odd and even numbers to 20.
- To understand that we can make maps and plans to represent places and use these to see where things are in relation to other things. The children will create a map to their new class.



To use non-standard units when measuring water for capacity.

Literacy- Reading, Writing and Phonics

This term we will be continuing to look at Phase 4 where we will be learning to practise reading and spelling words containing adjacent consonants such as (CVCC, CCVCC, CCCVC, CVCCC and CCCVCC words).



Adjacent Consonants— We will be learning to read and write words with adjacent clusters in e.g. sc for scarf

Reading Sentences—We will be using our keyword knowledge and phonic skills to read sentences with new words we have learnt in Phase 4.
