



Mathematics

Growing 67,8-We will be counting to 6, 7 and 8 and representing it in different ways and count out the required number of objects from a larger group. Arranging 6, 7 or 8 items into small groups continuing to subitise greater numbers E.g. I know it is 8 because I see 4 and 4 We will also order and compare their representations, noticing one more/less patterns as we count on and back to 8

Time-We will order and sequence important times in their day and use language such as now, before, later, soon, after, then and next to describe when events happen. We will also begin to recognise that regular events happen on the same day each weekend and use the vocabulary 'yesterday', 'today' and 'tomorrow' to describe when events happen.





Literacy- Reading, Writing and Phonics. Segmenting and Blending- We will continue to split words into their individual sounds and bringing those sounds together to make a word.

Making Pairs-We will match and find pairs, developing an understanding of what a pair is and explore putting larger amounts into pairs.

Reading Sentences- We will be using our keyword knowledge and phonic skills to read sentences.

Combining 2 groups-Begin to combine 2 groups to find how many altogether using everyday objects. Length and Height-Developing their language for length and height e.g. the tree is tall, the pencil is short.

Phase 3– We will be re-calling our Phase 3 phonemes, digraphs and trigraphs, hearing and finding them in words.
