










Class Charts

Uniform





It is incredibly important to us for the uniform to act as a social leveller, which is why we are asking for **no branding/logos** (e.g. Nike, Adidas etc) on items of clothing worn into school. These items should be reserved for wearing outside the school.

As you can imagine, for a school of our size, labelling of all clothing is vital.







This applies to the P.E. kit as well. A plain t-shirt and shorts. Sensible footwear and a black jumper or hoodie.

WE ARE A NUT FREE SCHOOL!

People who suffer from nut allergies can develop a severe, potentially lifethreatening allergic reaction. If someone has a nut allergy it is not just eating nuts that can cause a severe reaction, just being touched on the skin or smelling the breath of someone who has had nuts or a product containing nuts can trigger anaphylactic shock (which can cause breathing and swallowing difficulties).

- Lunches are not free for Junior school children. (£2.86). This means
 that from Year 3 onwards, meals are only free if your child is
 eligible for Free School Meals (FSM), based on your family's
 circumstances.

 - Supermarket vouchers during school holidays
 Free holiday programmes such as HAF Fun Pompey
 Additional funding for your child's school, helping us to
 enhance learning and resources
