

has shared with Miss Pullen the work he and his friends have completed with his Scouts group on conserving water. He worked incredibly hard and completed a survey on water use and the impact it has.


This is a fantastic responsible approach to the use of our resources Spencer – I hope you will apply to be one of our value ambassadors!
