HOW TO MEASURE YOUR CHILD

1. **HEIGHT**
Without shoes, with the back against the wall place feet together flat on the floor. Measure from the top of the head to the ground.
2. **NECK**
Measure around the base of the neck where the shirt collar would normally sit. Leave a little room for comfort.
3. **CHEST**
Measure the chest at the fullest part placing the tape close up under the arms.
4. **WAIST**
Measure around the natural waistline, at the narrowest part. Leave a little extra room for comfort.
5. **HIPS**
Measure straight, with heels together, measure around the fullest part.
6. **INSIDE LEG**
To best fit take the measurement from the top of the inside leg to the floor.

The Card is free and available to those who receive means-tested benefits living within PO1 – PO6 areas of the city (some properties in PO7 qualify where these pay council tax to Portsmouth City Council).

If you choose to opt-in to receive marketing emails, you will receive Leisure Card member updates on free and low-cost local events and activities happening within the city.

The Leisure Card is valid for 12 months and you can reapply when the card expires, if still eligible.

* How to apply: visit the Portsmouth City Council website, search for Leisure Card and apply online www.portsmouth.gov.uk or you can visit your local library, community centre or housing office and ask for an application form (please bring along proof of the benefits to be checked)

Eligible benefits.

- > Universal credit
- > Housing benefit
- > Council Tax Support (excludes statutory 25% single persons discount)
- > Pension credit (guarantee credit element only)
- > Foster carers with foster children (use the online application form and upload a signed letter from your supervising social worker as evidence)
