



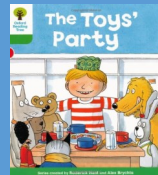
Curriculum Letter Autumn 2nd Half 2021

We are going to be learning about different celebrations this term e.g. Birthdays, Diwali, Christmas

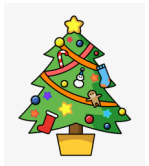

- To make 4/5 in different ways.
- To talk about night and day and what you do at these times.
- To talk about numbers 1 more or 1 less.
- To create shapes with 4 sides.



Understanding the World

We will be learning :

- To talk about what happens at birthday parties and to help plan a party for our alien friend 'Pootle'.
- To talk about different celebrations and the reasons for them e.g. Diwali/ Christmas
- To explore light sources.
- To talk about Remembrance Day.



Literacy- Phonics

We will be learning:

- New Super Power words 'and, the, to, a, said, he, in' Please also practise your keywords at home.
- To name some Phase 2 phonemes e.g. d,g,o,c,k,ck,e, r,h
- To segment and blend sounds together to form simple words when reading e.g s-a-t
