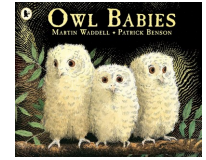


Curriculum Letter Autumn 1st Half 2021

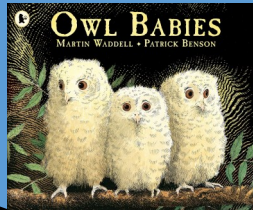


Time to fly!

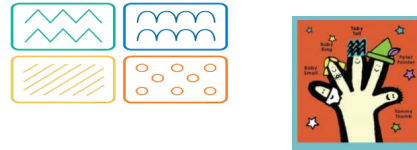
Understanding the World-

Dough Disco

We will be learning to:

- Develop our gross motor skills using play dough to practise our finger disco e.g rolling, sausage, lasso.
- Develop our strength and take part in funky finger activities e.g. picking up pom poms with tweezers.
- Keep safe in P.E. by being aware of others and the space around us.

Expressive Arts

We will be learning to:

- Draw ourselves.
- Take our pencil on a journey on paper.
- Explore different materials and use our imagination to create something.
- Sing and learn nursery rhymes.

Mathematics

We will be learning:



- To match amounts to the same group of objects.
- To carefully count objects 1-10.
- To make our own repeating patterns.
- To play a simple dice game.
- To join in with number rhymes that help our counting.
