State funeral of HM Elizabeth II School closure on Monday September 19th 2022

Dear Parents

As you will have heard over the weekend, Monday 19th September has been designated as a Bank Holiday, the day of the state funeral of HM Elizabeth II. This means that both King's Academy College Park schools will be closed next Monday.

Over the National period of Mourning we will support pupils as necessary in school and there will be some events within school that the children will experience. These will be adapted according to the age and needs of the children. As families in the local community, we would like to share the following information we have received from Portsmouth City Council. The following statement has been issued by The Right Worshipful the Lord Mayor of Portsmouth, Cllr Hugh Mason:

"On behalf of councillors and officers at Portsmouth City Council, I would like to express my deepest sadness following the recent announcement of the death of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth. I would like to take this opportunity to offer our condolences to the Royal Family, who remain in our thoughts and prayers at this very sad time."

Flags in the city are being flown at half-mast as a mark of respect.
