## Year 2 Residential trip to Stubbington Study Centre

Dear Parents/Carers,

We are excited to share with you information about our Year 2 residential trip to Stubbington Study Centre.

- The trip will take place on Thursday 23rd February & Friday 24th February 2022.
- The children will travel by coach from school on Thursday morning and return on Friday afternoon.
- The school has booked for 80 places (40 girls and 40 boys). It will be on a first come first served basis and payment is to be made via **Scopay**.
- Children who do not go on the trip will do similar activities back at school; they will not be required to wear school uniform for the two days and will work with members of staff who are not going to Stubbington.
- Staff will accompany the children for the two days and stay overnight with them. Mrs Richardson will also be going.
- Staff have already visited the Study Centre and a full written risk assessment will be undertaken again this year.
- The children sleep in small dormitories. There are shower facilities and all meals and snacks are included.
- All meals are catered for on-site and children with particular medical conditions/dietary requirements can be accommodated.
- A range of outdoor activities have been planned for the children to undertake including shelter building, map-reading, environmental games and badger watching!
- The cost of the trip is £102.55 and this includes <u>all transport, food, accommodation and</u> <u>educational activities</u>. We are happy to take a non-refundable deposit of £25.00 on Monday 10<sup>th</sup> October via Scopay. This will go live at 12pm. This is because places will be allocated on a first come, first serve basis and deposits will be recorded as soon as they are received.
- Further instalments will then be due on the following dates:

Friday 4th November £25.85 (balance of £50.85)

Friday 2nd December £25.85 (balance of £76.70)

Friday 6th January £25.85 (full balance of £102.55)

You can choose to pay more throughout these dates via Scopay as long as you have paid the balance amount by those dates.

- The aim of the trip is to encourage and promote children's confidence, independence, self-esteem and co-operative skills using the outdoors and overnight experience. It has been a huge success in previous years and is remembered fondly by former pupils.
