The gates will open at **12:15**. Family members are asked to enter through their child's usual gate as the children will be situated in their 'lining up areas', (siblings may choose one of their areas to sit together). Once we have all had the chance to enjoy a tasty picnic lunch and share some books together, parents/carers will have the option to take their children home early. If this choice is made, parents/carers **must sign their child out** with their class teacher, who will be monitoring their area, before leaving the school site. Members of the Senior Leadership Team will monitor the gates throughout the event.

On the day, we will be hosting a shared picnic for which you may bring in food from home, remembering that we are a **nut-free school**, or choose for your child to be provided with a school packed lunch.
