Year 6 will be taking part in a series of activities over the final 2 weeks of term. Below is a timetable of the activities.

In the first week of activities, each class will have an opportunity to visit the park. A printed letter will be sent home with your child to gain your consent for this activity. Without your permission, the children will not be able to take part in this visit. We would also like each class to stay for a picnic lunch. Please could you make sure your child attends with a packed lunch, on their classes chosen day. Children who are entitled to free school meals will be able to order a school packed lunch of cheese, ham or egg through their class teacher.

On Wednesday 19th July, during school time, the Year 6 children will be running their Annual Fundraiser. The aim of the day is for the children to independently organise an event that will raise funds with which something can be bought for the whole school - to leave as a legacy. The school would appreciate the support of parents/carers to provide a voluntary donation of £1.00 to purchase some small prizes for this occasion. Your child will let you know what event they will be organising.

The whole school will have an opportunity during the day to buy goods and services that the Year 6 children have organised. If your child could bring change (rather than notes) to spend on the day that would be much appreciated.

On Tuesday 18th July, we are holding a Leavers Disco for the Year 6 children between 5.00 and 6.30 p.m. There will be no food at this event but refreshments and ice-lollies will be provided.
