Dear Parents/Carers,

You will find enclosed a souvenir order form and a medical and consent form for the upcoming residential. Please return the completed forms to the school office no later than **Friday 26th January 2024**.

Below is a reminder of our suggested Kit List for your child. **PLEASE NAME ALL ITEMS** as far as possible and pack a copy of the Kit List so your child knows what to pack to bring home.

- Trainers (that your child can put on/take off and **do up for themselves**)
- Wellington boots (in a named carrier bag tied to their main case/travel bag)
- Anorak or warm coat (must be waterproof)
- Jeans or Tracksuit bottoms (at least 2 pairs in case the weather is wet)
- Pyjamas or nightdress
- Large towel & flannel
- Socks and underwear (including spares in case we get wet)
- Gloves, hat, scarf
- Sweatshirt, t-shirt (at least 2 pairs in case the weather is wet)
- Slippers and dressing-gown
- Toiletries in a sponge bag – including shower cap, toothpaste, toothbrush, body wash/shower gel, hairbrush. The children will not be washing their hair when they shower on Thursday evening so shampoo will not be required. Please also do not include any deodorant aerosols
- Cuddly toy
- Water bottle

ALL IN A CASE/BAG THAT IS CLEARLY NAMED!

- **NO electrical items or other valuables are permitted to be brought on the trip**
- **The children do not need to bring any food with them as they will be well catered for**

On Thursday 29th February, please bring your child to school at the normal time, dressed ready for the trip. Please take them and their case/travel bag to the Infant Hall. We suggest you say "Goodbye" and leave their belongings there so they can then go into their classrooms on their own. We will be leaving by coach later on in the morning and would rather parents did not stay to wave us off as it may be too distressing for you - not the children!

All medicines, asthma inhalers etc should be handed to Mrs Green who will be waiting in the Hall to receive them.

The children may bring £2.00 pocket money with them to spend in the tuck shop, but it must be in a named purse/wallet/envelope (which can be packed in their case). The shop has a selection of souvenirs that the children can choose from and they can also buy a sweet or chocolate treat.

On the first evening of the trip, Mrs Richardson will send a message to parents on ParentMail to give you an update about all the fun they've had so far!

We shall be returning on Friday 1st March in the afternoon. You may arrive to collect your child from their classroom at 3pm, then their belongings and any medication, from the school Hall.
